Nairm Marr Djambana has commissioned the creative design of bespoke community art lanterns. which will feature at community event on 28 May 2021. The lanterns, designed by illuminart Australia, will be decorated with designs that are going to be developed by our community in workshops during April and May. The designs will be printed onto fabric which will illuminate from within the lanterns. The tall cylindrical design featuring motifs designed by participants from Nairm Marr Djambana will be uniquely for our community and we will be able to present the lanterns at special

times for various celebrations both indoors and outside. Stay tuned for workshop details if you want to participate.


After the light festival, NMD plans to have a travelling exhibition. NMD is currently speaking to various galleries.
